A new 'Vision' for Vatukarasa

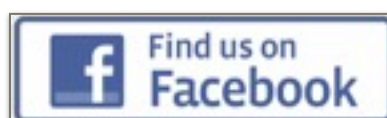
A recent visit to the Vatukarasa Clinic in July this year saw the distribution of some **500** pairs of reading glasses to local communities.

MEDICAL STUDENTS TRAVEL TO CORAL COAST

Medical students Liesel Woon and Sarah Andela from Sydney University (Nepean Campus) recently experienced 'first hand' the work of Vatu Health Inc.

The students travelled to Fiji with Adrian & Suzy Sheen and were able to assist in screening some 350 locals at both resorts and villages along the Coral Coast.

"The information collected will be summarised in reports for the resorts and communities screened with the hope that the information can help identify the main health issues to be addressed"

The students were able to visit the Vatu Health Clinic and assist the nurses and see first-hand how wonderful a service they provide, given the lack of medical supplies and general clinic facilities.
